

Salem County Board of Taxation

The June 17th, 2020 Monthly Meeting of the Salem County Board of Taxation was called to order by President Steven Caltabiano at 8:30 AM.

Compliance with The Open Public Meeting Act was recognized. A roll call of Tax Board members indicated that all members were present. Commissioner Behnke participated telephonically. Also in attendance were John Snyder Tax Administrator and Kathy McAllister Administrative Clerk, OPRA Custodian.

The Meeting Minutes for the Reorganization meeting in May were reviewed and approved; Crouch/Hall 5-0

Under the Administrators report Mr. Snyder informed the Board that we have tentatively scheduled hearings for July 28th at 5:00PM with a Tax Board meeting @ 4:30 PM. Kathy McAllister informed the Board that we have currently received 292 Tax Appeals.

Under Unfinished Business Mr. Snyder informed the Commissioner's that the Elsinboro Revaluation will be postponed one year. Resolution prepared sent before end of year.

Under Sr1a Summary Report Review, John informed the Commissioners that due to the Pandemic he has excused the Assessors from compliance.
