

# Salem County Board of Taxation

The **August 25th, 2020** Monthly Meeting of the Salem County Board of Taxation was called to order by President Steven Caltabiano at 4:30 PM. in the Salem County Board of Taxation's office. Compliance with The Open Public Meeting Act was recognized. A roll call of Tax Board members indicated that all members were present.

The minutes for the July Monthly Board Meeting were presented for review and were unanimously approved. Motion Voros/Hall 5-0.

In the **Administrator's report** John Snyder informed the Commissioners that the cut-off date for roll-back complaints will be September 1st with hearings to be held at our regularly scheduled meeting on September 15th if necessary.

John also informed the Commissioners that all SR-1A data required by the Division of Taxation for the sampling period ending June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020 has been collected and submitted by Kathy McAllister.
