

## Salem County Board of Taxation

The **September 15th, 2020** Monthly Meeting of the Salem County Board of Taxation was called to order by President Steven Caltabiano at 4:30 P.M. in the Salem County Board of Taxation's office. Compliance with The Open Public Meeting Act was recognized. A roll call of Tax Board members indicated that all were present. Also in attendance, Administrator John Snyder, Administrative Clerk/OPRA Custodian Kathy McAllister and Alex Bauer, Assistant to the Tax Administrator.

The minutes for the August Monthly Board Meeting were presented for review and were approved on a Motion: Hall/Voros 5-0

**Under the Administrator's Report,** John informed the Commissioners that Tax Rates have not been struck for Salem City or Penn's Grove due to their failure to pass a budget. John issued Preliminary report containing Tax Rates for all other towns. John informed the Commissioners the Elsinboro Revaluation order has been extended by the State to be completed in 2021 for the 2022 Tax year. John asked the Board to support Alex Bauer status to be changed from temporary part time Assistant to the Tax Administrator to permanent. Hours not to exceed 8 hours per month was recommended and approved by Stacy Pennington. Voros/Hall 5-0

**Under Unfinished Business/SR1A Review,** All Municipalities were in compliance with Board 60 day turnaround policy.
