

Salem County Board of Taxation

The January 13th, 2021 Monthly Meeting of the Salem County Board of Taxation was called to order by President Steven Caltabiano in the Salem County Board of Taxation's office. Compliance with The Open Public Meeting Act was recognized. A roll call of Tax Board members indicated that all members were present except Commissioner Behnke. President Caltabiano, Administrator Snyder, and Administrative Clerk Kathy McAllister were present. Commissioner's Hall, Voros, Crouch, Special Assistant to the Tax Administrator Alex Bauer and Marie Procacci, Elsinboro Assessor participated by conference call.

The December Board Meeting Minutes were presented, reviewed and unanimously approved. Hall/Voros 4-0

In the Administrator's report John Snyder asked for a motion to accept and certify Municipal Tax List's as submitted. Crouch/Hall 4-0

Marie Procacci Elsinboro Tax Assessor spoke to the difficulty of proceeding with the Elsinboro revaluation order due to the probability of being unable to conduct interior inspections. President Caltabiano concurred and made a motion to postpone or cancel the Revaluation Order. Motion passed Caltabiano/Crouch 4-0
