

## **Salem County Board of Taxation**

The February 17th, 2021 Monthly Meeting of the Salem County Board of Taxation was called to order by President Steven Caltabiano at 8:30 AM.

Compliance with The Open Public Meeting Act was recognized. A roll call of Tax Board members indicated that all members were present. President Caltabiano was in the office with John Snyder and Kathy McAllister. Commissioner's Hall, Voros, Crouch, Behnke and Special Assistant to the Administrator, Alex Bauer participated telephonically.

The meeting minutes for January were presented for review and were unanimously approved. Hall/Voros 5-0

In the Administrator's Report John Snyder informed the Commissioner's that the County and Municipal Budget Cap exceptions have been calculated and communicated to County Treasure and Municipal CFO's.

Preliminary Equalization presented and approved. Hall/Voros 5-0

The Commissioner's reviewed the Civil Solutions Contract for \$3,000.00 for 2021. After some discussion contract was approved Hall/Voros 5-0

Kathy McAllister informed the Board that we have received 14 appeals to date.

In the President's Report Steven Caltabiano advised the Commissioner's and the Administrator that Tax Appeal Hearings will again be held this year on Tuesday nights in the Salem County Courthouse, 92 Market St., Salem City, in April, May, June, commencing at 5:00PM until conclusion.

Under New Business/Commissioner Concerns; Kathy McAllister distributed updated hours and contact information for Salem County Tax Assessors and Tax Collector's.

Under Old Business the Board accepted the letter from the N.J. Division of Taxation cancelling the Elsinboro Revaluation at our request.
